

Animal Healing information

When healing is going to be given to the animal it is important they are not involved in vigorous physical activity but free to move and in a safe familiar environment where they could happily rest. It is also helpful to have water available for the animal to drink.

Permission must be given by the owner or animal centre manager/handler. An email request for healing together with a photo of the animal and confirmation of animal centre approval if appropriate will constitute permission to heal.

Healing day preparations.

It can be helpful to prepare the room where the animal will be to receive the healing. Cleansing the room with Holy water, smudge, clapping in the corners or ringing a small bell all with the intention of clearing out any negative energy and bringing in the light, love and harmony can be helpful. Fresh flowers can also be helpful.

Before or during the healing session some animals may decide to leave the room. This is completely fine and will not diminish the healing. The healing will still continue.

Make sure you will not be interrupted and you have your phone. Make sure its charged up!

You may want to have a notepad to jot down any information I receive during the healing about your animal. Animal healing tends to have an immediate effect on animals but in some cases it can take a few days.
